



NOISE SCREEN ON LANGESKOV STATION

190 m noise screen established under major safety precautions

DAV NORDIC A/S has established a noise screen at the new Langeskov Station while trains have been passing at high speed and the power lines have been live. It has required great security measures and high expertise. Noise screen adapted to current conditions

The noise screen is a Banedanmark noise screen, which is adapted to the current conditions at Langeskov Station. The noise shield is bolted to the platform edge instead of the normal fixation with steel foundations in the ground. 190 m noise screen has been supplied at a 2 m height. Existing steel panels from the previous screen have been reused, but the load-bearing construction and the noise-absorbing stretch metal cassettes are new. The work was ready for the inauguration of Hans Christian Schmidt on 4 October 2015.
